

**Burials from *L'Assomption-de-la-Pointe-de-Montréal-du-Détroit*, 14 July 1784 – 31 October 1792: Part 2**

[Note: Names in brackets at the end of some entries indicate the presiding priest and will also serve to show how long that priest was at *L'Assomption* in present-day, Windsor, Ontario.<sup>1</sup> Names are as written in the original parish register. Additional material, in brackets, is the transcriber's comments. The dates are burial dates.]

**Jean Baptiste Prudhomme**, son of Jean Baptiste Prudhomme *dit* Nantais and Marie Délard from the parish of Ste. Anne [de Detroit]; about nine months, 14 July 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier [Hubert *ptre.*]<sup>2</sup>

**Philippe LeDuc**, about 55 years, 15 July 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Jean Baptiste LeDuc, Bigra and several others

**Therese**, *negresse*, daughter of Polly, *negresse* of [Rivard *dit* Loranger *dit*] Maisonville; three and a half months, 26 July 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier

**Pierre Deschênes**, son of Joseph [Miville *dit*] Deschênes and Charlotte [Leduc *dite*] Souligny; three years, 2 August 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier<sup>3</sup>

**Pierre**, *panis*<sup>4</sup> of Phillippe LeDuc; 26 months, 4 August 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier

**Jérôme Delisle**, son of Jean [Bienvenu *dit*] Delisle and Angélique [Maillet *dite*] Boiscler, from the parish of Ste. Anne de Detroit; one month, 14 August 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier<sup>5</sup>

**Angelique Labombarde**, daughter of Philippe [Bombardier *dit*] LaBombarde and Marguerite Briette [Brouillet]; about two months, 20 August 1784, buried in cemetery<sup>6</sup>

**Dominique Parent**, son of Laurent Parent and Magdeleine Janis; about two years, 27 August 1784, buried in cemetery

**Francois** [François de Sales] **Parent**, son of Jacques Parent and Catherine Cuillerier [*dite* Beaubien]; two and a half years, 31 August 1784, buried in cemetery

The material contained in the above transcription, as well as the previous and subsequent transcriptions, in *Michigan's Habitant Heritage (MHH)* of *L'Assomption*, from 1768-1805, has more information than the contents of *SL*, the published book. The burials of illegitimate children and slaves are not mentioned in *SL*. In some cases, there are discrepancies between the spelling of the family names in the book and in the actual parish registers. Some burials, in particular young children, are not recorded. Also, in many cases, the date of death is given, not the burial date.

**Josette Bernier**, daughter of Charles Bernier and Marie Louise Godet; four months, 4 September 1784, buried in cemetery<sup>7</sup>

**Antoine Rousseau dit Lafond**, about 68 years, 10 September 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Pageot, Roy, Bigra and several others<sup>8</sup>

**Suzanne Patelle** [Billy *dite* Patel, Putelle, Bey/Le Bey],<sup>9</sup> wife of Jean Baptiste Oualet [Ouellet/Ouellette]; about 35 years, 13 September 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bouron, Valcour and a large number of people

**Francois Campau**, son of Francois Campau and Marie Catherine Ro [Rau]; two months, 4 October 1784, [burial location not specified], buried in the presence of Bigra and Gagnier<sup>10</sup>

**Joseph Brugieres**, about 45 years, 13 October 1784, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra, Gagnier and others<sup>11</sup>

A note in the parish register between the end of the year 1784 and the beginning of the year 1785: “1 January 1785, about 8 a.m. [Marie Anne] **Ménard**, wife of [Pierre Chulle *dit*] Bélair, drowned, with a little girl of **Demers**, while crossing the river in a *carriole* [*cariole* – sleigh]. The wife of Demers who was holding a child, about one-year-old, in her arms, was pulled from the water with her child by her husband as well as the little [female] Bélair and Duroseau who ... the body of the wife of Demers.”

A child of Louis **Suzor** and Josette LeBeau, born 15 January 1785, *ondoié*<sup>12</sup> at home, buried 16 January 1785 in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier<sup>13</sup>

**Paul Drouillard**, son of Jean Baptiste Drouillard and Marie Louise [Charlotte] Drouin; died at *olsandoskie* [*sic*] 31 December 1784 at the age of about one and a half years, buried 20 January 1785 in cemetery<sup>14</sup>

Anne de Detroit and *L'Assomption de Sandwich*. When Magdeleine Bouron remarried in 1753, her deceased husband's name was spelled as *Patelle* [Kelley, ed., 9]. Susanne *Patel*, daughter of Jean Baptiste Patel and Magdelaine Bouron, married Jean Baptiste Oilette, 7 January 1765, at Ste. Anne de Detroit. In the *L'Assomption* records she was Susanne *Patene* [Kelley, ed., 18]. In the baptisms of her children at *L'Assomption*, she was Susanne *Bey* or *Le Bey* [*L'Assomption de Sandwich de Windsor, 1767-1783*, images 3 of 62, 5 of 62, 12 of 62, 18 of 62, 30 of 62 and 41 of 62]. When their son, Bazile, was born and baptized 27 April 1785 at *L'Assomption*, his father, Charles, was deceased. Father Hubert was the priest for the burial of “Joseph” and the baptism of Bazile. He called the mother of Bazile “Catherine Makoun.” *SL*, 32, indicates that *Joseph* was 40 years old. Maconce is sometimes a *dit* name for Fafard. - [Jean Baptiste] **Valcour**, son of Joseph Valcour and the deceased Josette Makons [Fafard *dite* Maconce]; about three years, 9 March 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier
- Joseph Lesueur**, *natif de la paroisse de Boucherville en Canada*, about 61 years, 17 March 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra, Gagnier and several others
- Twins, born 6 April 1785, of Michel **Arcouët** and Marie-Anne Laforêt, *ondoiés* at home by the midwife and died shortly after, buried 6 April 1785 in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier<sup>15</sup>
- Charlotte Oualet** [Ouellet/Ouellette], daughter of Alexandre Oualet *dit* Conflans and Angélique Bourassa; about three years, 23 April 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier
- Francois Godet Marentet**, husband of Jeanne Parent; about 64 years, 24 May 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Labrosse, Jacques and Laurent Parent, and several others<sup>16</sup>
- Marie Anne**, *panise* of Joseph Rochelot [Rochereau *dit* Lespérance]; nine years, 26 May 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier
- Lisette** [Marie Louise] **Campau**, wife of Antoine Meloche, and her child; about 36 years, 5 June 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra, Gagnier and several others
- Michel Roy**, husband of Jeannette Villers [*dite* St. Louis]; about 32 years, 10 July 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Thomas Pageot, Louis Villers and several others
- A child of Francois **Sourdillet** [Sordelier] and Josette Gendron; *ondoié* at home and died shortly afterwards; buried 12 July 1785, [burial location not specified]<sup>17</sup>
- Josette** [Marie Jeanne] **Gendron**, wife of Francois Sourdillet [Sordelier]; about 40 years, 14 July 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier
- Francois Fontaine**, son of Charles Fontaine and Elizabeth Godfroy [*dite* St. Georges]; eight and a half months, 14 July 1785, buried in cemetery
- Jacques**, *nègre* of Pierre Réaume; about 60 years, 20 July 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier
- Céleste Labombarde**, daughter of Pierre [Philippe] [Bombardier *dit*] Labombarde and Marguerite Brouillet; one month, 24 July 1785, buried in cemetery<sup>18</sup>
- Joseph**, illegitimate [no parents named], born 14 July 1785, buried 4 August 1785, [burial location not specified]
- A child of Pierre **L'Etourneau** and Louise [Delières *dite*] Bonvouloir; *ondoié* by the midwife and died shortly afterwards, 10 August 1785, buried in cemetery<sup>19</sup>
- Marguerite**, *panise* of Réaume; about 40 years, 29 August 1785, buried in cemetery
- Charlotte Campeau**, wife of [Joseph] Droüin; [no age given], 4 September 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigra and Francois Campau
- Pierre Réaume**, died 18 September 1785 in the parish of St<sup>e</sup>. Anne, about 77 years, buried 19 September 1785 in church [*l'Assomption*] in presence of M<sup>r</sup> Payet *curé de* St<sup>e</sup> Anne, M<sup>r</sup> Maisonville Cap<sup>n</sup> and several others [Payet *Ptre Miss.*, Hubert *Pt. V. G.*]<sup>20</sup>
- [Marie Angélique] **Bénéteau**, about five years, 24 September 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Girardin [Hubert *ptre. G.*]
- Joseph Bénéteau**, 13 months, 27 September 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Gagnier
- Archange** [Bernard *dite*] **Lajoie**, 14 months, 4 October 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigra and Jacques Gagnier [Payet, *ptre. Miss.*]

- Louise Drouillard**,<sup>21</sup> three years, 17 October 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigra and Girardin [Frèchette, *ptre miss.*]
- Vital Gaillard**, two months and a half, 21 October 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigra and Girardin<sup>22</sup>
- Etienne Ripus**, about 104 years, 30 November 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of François Gaillard, Amable Bigras, Girardin, Dechaine and several others
- Pierre Meloche**, son of Pierre Meloche,  *fils* [Jr.] and [Marie Catherine Campau]; 18 months, 14 December 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigra and Girardin<sup>23</sup>
- Joseph Picotte**, about 58 years, 20 December 1785, buried in cemetery in presence of Peltier,  *marguillier* [church warden], Bigras, Parent and several others<sup>24</sup>
- Magdelaine Jacob**, 14 years, 7 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigras, Duseaut, Hubert, Girardin, and several others
- Marie Louise Valade**, daughter of Jean Baptiste Valade [*dit* Lajeunesse] and Marie Louise Drouillard; two years and three months, 12 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigras, Girardin and others
- Jean Baptiste Sumandre** [Soumande], one year, 13 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigras, Girardin and others
- Catherine Meloche**, wife of Andrée [*sic*] Peltier; 36 years, 15 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Badichon, Reaume, Chapoton and several others
- J. Baptiste Gaudette** [Gaudet in margin], about three years, 19 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras, Girardin and others
- Catherine Valcour**, about six and a half years, 19 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras and Girardin
- Chrisostome Pageot**, four years, 21 January 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras and Girardin
- Magdelaine**, *panisse* of Berthiaume; 11 years, 1 February 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras, Gaillard, Girardin and others
- Jacque Berthiaume**, nine years, 10 February 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Maisonville, Pillet, Deshetre and several others
- A child of Joseph **Hivons** [Yvon] and Marguerite Sordillet [Sordelier], his wife; about one year, died 9 February 1786 at *Sansdosqué* [probably present-day, Sandusky, Ohio] and buried 17 February 1786 in cemetery in presence of Bigras, *père et fils* [father and son]
- Catharine Theraize L'anglais**, 11 years, 25 February 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras, Peltier  *fils* [son], Gaillard and others
- Jean Baptiste André**, eight years, 9 April 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Girardin, Bigras and others
- Antoine Berthiaume**, son of Joseph Berthiaume and Catharine Pilet; about one year, 9 May 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras, Girardin and others<sup>25</sup>
- A child of Pierre **Letourneau** and Louise [Delière *dite*] Bonvouloir, his wife;  *ondoié* by the midwife at home and died shortly after, buried 30 July 1786 in cemetery in presence of Bigras and Girardin
- Josette**, *panisse* of Lamarche; 11 years, 11 August 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras, Boulet and others
- Charles Meloche**, about 12 years, 18 August 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Baptiste Bigras, Etienne Meloche, Cloutier and several others
- Pierre Morin**, *voyageur*, about 57 years, 22 August 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Langlois, Charon, Pratte and several others<sup>26</sup>

- Pierre Denoyer** [Desnoyers], about 66 years, 26 August 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Lajoy, Jacque Parent, Marentet and several others<sup>27</sup>
- Marie**, *négresse libre* [free Negro woman], about 72 years, 21 September 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Monforton, Joseph Reaume, Laderoute and others
- Alexis Paré**, died at 6 a.m. on 25 September 1786, as the result of a thunderbolt in his father's house in the presence of all his family and two strangers who were in the house. Alexis, about 23 years, was buried 26 September 1786 in the cemetery in the presence of Baptiste Pillet, Joseph Reaume, René Cloutier and several others
- François Meloche**, about 53 years, 25 October 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Charles Dominique Janson Lapalme *père* and Charles François Janson  *fils*. [Dufaux, *ptre*]
- René Gatien**, about 47 years, 29 November 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Beauchant [Beauchamp] and Bigras [*dit* Fauvel]
- André Bergeron**, son of Simon Bergeron and Catherine Lebeau; 23 years, 11 December 1786, buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Beauchant [Beauchamp] and Amable Bigras [*dit* Fauvel]<sup>28</sup>
- A child of Antoine **Soumande** and Angélique [Guillet *dite*] Tourangeau; *ondoyé* at home 7 January 1787 and buried 8 January 1787 in cemetery in presence of Amable Bigras [*dit* Fauvel]<sup>29</sup>
- Louis Charby**, *natif* of the parish of *la valterie en Canada*, about 40 years, 19 January 1787, buried in cemetery in presence of Beauchamp and Amable Bigras [*dit* Fauvel], *bedeau* [beadle, verger (caretaker of church interior)]<sup>30</sup>
- Marie Catherine Labut** [Chesne *dite* Labutte], wife of Dequinde [Charles Stanislas Dagneau De Quindre *dit* Fontenay]; 26 years, 3 March 1787, buried in cemetery in presence of Beauchant [Beauchamp], *chantre* [cantor], and Bigras [*dit* Fauvel], *bedeau*<sup>31</sup>
- Joseph Saltien** [Saulquin/Solquin *dit* St. Joseph], son of Joseph Saltien and Catherine Lauson; 21 years, 3 March 1787, buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Beauchant [Beauchamp], *chantre*, and Jean Baptiste Bigras [*dit* Fauvel], *bedeau*<sup>32</sup>
- Seraphin Lacroix**, about 61 years, 7 March 1787, buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Beauchant [Beauchamp] and Jean Baptiste Bigras [*dit* Fauvel], *bedeau*
- Alexis Cousineau**, son of Louis Cousineau and Marie d'avignon [Marie Françoise Davignon *dite* Beauregard]; seven months, 28 February [*sic*- the month before and after this entry is April] 1787, buried in cemetery in presence of Bigras [*dit* Fauvel], *bedeau*, and Bissonnet<sup>33</sup>
- Elizabeth Rapin**, widow of Joseph [Dinan/Dignan *dit*] St. Etienne; 72 years, 8 May 1787,<sup>34</sup> buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Beauchant [Beauchamp], *chantre*, and Amable Bigras [*dit* Fauvel]<sup>35</sup>
- Nicolas Langlois**, found drowned on the banks [*rives*] de *l'isle à la pierre* [Stone Island], according to the verbal account made by *la justice*; [no age given], 24 May 1787, buried in cemetery in presence of Beauchant [Beauchamp] and Bigras [*dit* Fauvel]

**André Berthiaume**, son of Joseph Berthiaume and Catherine Pillet; one and a half months, 25 June 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel and Theodor Prat <sup>83</sup>

**René** [Douillard *dit*] **Laprise**, 3 July 1792, [no age given], buried in the cemetery in presence of Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel and Laurent Réaume <sup>84</sup>

“He had died several days previously and had been found dead in a field of wheat, penetrated in several spots on his body by insects and wild animals, according to the testimony of several *habitants* [inhabitants] of the parish, namely Julient [*sic*] Parent, Vital Dumouchel, Joseph Langlois and several others who attested to the same declaration.”

**Félicité Bombardier**, daughter of Philippe Bombardier [*dit* Labombarde] and Marie Marguerith Brouillet; about two months, 9 July 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel and Theodor Prat <sup>85</sup>

**Pierre Trudel**, son of Louis Trudel and Susanne Denoyer [Desnoyers]; 15 days, 15 August 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Alexis Parent and Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel <sup>86</sup>

**Gervais Hodiène**, son of Gervais Hodiène and Marie Charles Minville [Miville *dite* Deschênes]; 11 months, 16 August 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel and Mainville *fil*s <sup>87</sup>

**Thereze Desplats**, daughter of Jacques Desplats [Desplas] and Françoise Reveau [Revau *dite* Lajeunesse]; six and a half months, 17 August 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Parent and Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel <sup>88</sup>

**Louis Bourguignon**, son of Louis [Dignier *dit*] Bourguignon and Theotiste Paré; 20 days, 18 September 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Alexis Paré and Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel <sup>89</sup>

**Cécile Bourassa**, daughter of Louis Bourassa and Thereze Meloche; about eight years, 29 September 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Etienne Meloche and Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel <sup>90</sup>

**Jean Baptiste Cloutier**, son of Zacarie Cloutier and Thereze Campau; [no age given], 31 October 1792, buried in cemetery in presence of Amable [Bigras *dit*] Fauvel and Antoine Boufard
