

**Burials from *L'Assomption-de-la-Pointe-de-Montréal-du-Detroit*, 12 July 1800 - 27 December 1805: Part 4**

[Note: Names in brackets at the end of some entries indicate the presiding priest and will also serve to show how long that priest was at *L'Assomption* in present-day, Windsor, Ontario.<sup>1</sup> Names are as written in the original parish register. The standardized spelling of a family name, complete with known *dit*-names, will be given the first time the name appears. Additional material, in brackets, is the transcriber's comments. The dates are burial dates.]

**Angélique Bergeron**, daughter of Simon Bergeron and Agathe Béneteau; 10 days, 12 July 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesne [Hodienne], *bedeau*, and Chrisostome Pajot [Pageot] [Marchand, *ptre*]<sup>2</sup>

**Antoine Janis**, son of François Janis and Jenevieve [Delière/Deslières *dite*] Bonvouloir; 14 days, 19 July 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Chrisostome Pajot and Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*<sup>3</sup>

**Archange Flemin**, daughter of Guillaume Flemin [William Fleming], captain in the Marines on the Lake for his British Majesty, and Archange Crequy [Aide *dite* Créquy]; eight months and 20 days, 19 July 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Christophe Barabée and Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*<sup>4</sup>

**Monique Tacheleau**, daughter of Joseph Tacheleau [Taschereau] and Thérèse from the *rivierre Tamise*<sup>5</sup> in this parish; three years and four months, 22 July 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of François Senet and Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*<sup>6</sup>

**Vital Réaume**, son of Pierre Réaume and Magdeleine Dumouchelle [Dumouchel]; 21 days, 22 July 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of François Senet and Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*<sup>7</sup>

**Anne**, *panise esclave* of Laurent Parent; about 43 years, 13 August 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Laurent Parent, her master, and Jean Baptiste Parent, his son

**Ethienne Marchand**, son of Ethienne Marchand and Marguerite Dumini [Dumesnil *dite* Lamusique]; 33 years, 30 August 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of François Marchand, his brother, and Pierre Dufour<sup>8</sup>

**François**, born of unknown parents; about 20 months, 10 September 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Chrisostome Pajot and Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*<sup>9</sup>

Also, in many cases, the date of death is given, not the burial date.

- Catherine Girard**, wife of Jaques Bésaire [Bezer *dit* Léveillé] *fil*s; 17 years, 16 September 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Antoine Boufard [Bouffard] *père* and Antoine Meloche *père*<sup>10</sup>
- Catherine Mété**, daughter of Pierre Mété [Métay] and Catherine Meloche, from *la rivière rouge* parish of Ste. Anne [de Detroit], diocese of Baltimore; died in the parish of *L'Assomption*, aged [left blank] days, 25 October 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*, and Chrisostôme Pajot<sup>11</sup>
- Pierre Plante**, from the parish of St. Antoine on *la rivière du loup* in Lower Canada [present-day Province of Québec], 62 years, 5 November 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Antoine Meloche *père* and Alexandre Fauvelle [Bigras *dit* Fauvel]<sup>12</sup>
- Catherine Meloche**, wife of Pierre Mété, from the parish of Ste. Anne du Détroit, diocese of Baltimore; close to 19 years old, 7 November 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Antoine Boufard *père* and Alexis Langlois<sup>13</sup>
- Magdeleine [Lareau]**, widow of [Louis] Bineau; about 83 years, 25 November 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Thomas Pajot and Pierre Chauvin [difficult to decipher]<sup>14</sup>
- Suzanne Caupucin** [Thiriot *dite* Capucin], wife of Joseph Robert; about 37 years, 2 December 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Pierre [Villers *dit*] St. Louis and Joseph Bazinet<sup>15</sup>
- Jean Baptiste Reveau dit Lajeunesse** [Jean Louis Revau *dit* Lajeunesse], 80 years old, 12 December 1800, buried in cemetery in presence of Antoine Boufard *fil*s and Louis Piché *dit* ...<sup>16</sup>
- Brigitte Labelle**, daughter of Antoine Labelle and Magdeleine Audet [*dite* Lapointe]; 17 days, 10 January 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Pierre Amable Fauvelle *dit* Bigras and Jean Deschene [Miville *dit* Deschênes]<sup>17</sup>
- Jean Charles Reneau** [Renaud], about 60 years, 26 January 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Jean Baptiste Gignac and Jean Baptiste Antailla [Peltier/Pelletier *dit* Antaya]<sup>18</sup>
- Jaques Bézaire**, son of Jaques Bézaire [Bezer *dit* Léveillé] and the deceased Catherine Girard; four and a half months, 27 January 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*, and Chrisostôme Pajot<sup>19</sup>
- Josephte Bertrand**, daughter of Jean Baptiste Bertrand *dit* Laruche and Marguerithe Paré; two months, 3 February 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesne and Ig[n]ace Minville [Miville *dit* Deschênes]
- Jean Baptiste Mélice [sic] Belleperche**, son of Jaques Belleperche and Cecile Lauson; about 37 hours, 14 February 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesnes, *bedeau*, and Joseph Hodiesnes<sup>20</sup>
- Brigitte Fauvelle**, daughter of Alexandre Fauvelle and Josette Cloutier; about 16 months, 26 February 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesne and François Dufour [Gabriel Richard, *ptre*]
- Gabriël Rousson**, son of Jean Baptiste Rousson and Marie Josette Drouillard; about eight days, 1 March 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Gervais Hodiesne
- Charles** [Casse *dit*] **St. Aubin**, about 87 years, 24 March 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Charles Lauson, his grandson, and Gabriel [Audet *dit*] Lapointe *fil*s [Marchand, *ptre*]
- Marie Jeanne Pouget**, daughter of Charles Pouget and Marianne Pajot; 25 months, 27 March 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Chrisostôme Pajot and Gervais Hodiesne, *bedeau*<sup>21</sup>

- Elisabette Park**, daughter of Jean [Jonas] Park and Pauline Catin [Appoline Catin *dite* Deplaine<sup>22</sup>]; three years and four months, 16 April 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Jean Park, her father, and Bernard [Rivard *dit* Loranger *dit*] Maisonville
- Magdeleine Valet**, wife of Gabriel Audet *dit* Lapointe; 62 years, 2 May 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Jaques Charon and Augustin [Charon *dit*] Cabanac<sup>23</sup>
- Therese Lydie**, *panise* of Joseph Pilet; 34 months, 3 June 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Hodiesne and Isaac Minville
- Gervais Hodiesne**, *bedeau*, about 54 years, 17 June 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Jean Baptiste Gignac, *marguillier en charge* [churchwarden in charge], and Jaques Parent, *ancien [sic] marguillier* [former church warden]<sup>24</sup>
- Angélique Prud-homme**, daughter of Pierre Prud-homme [Prudhomme] and Marie Louise Meloche; about four years, 24 June 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Joseph Hodiesne and Isaac Minville<sup>25</sup>
- Antoine Bernier**, son of Charles Bernier and Therese Labadie [Descompte/Descomps *dite* Labadie]; three years, 6 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Chrysostome Pajeau and Etienne Giguere [Giguère]<sup>26</sup>
- Child of Louis **Plante** and [...] Lebeau; *ondoyé à la maison*,<sup>27</sup> born the same day, 9 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Etienne Guiguerre, *bedeau*, and Joseph Mallioux [Mailloux] [F. Gatien *ptre*]<sup>28</sup>
- Charles Ouislan [sic]**, 24 years, a young man from the city or environs of Québec *dans le Bas Canada*, 9 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Antoine Soumandre [Soumande], Thomas Martineau and Antoine Prévot [Prévoist] [Marchand *ptre*]<sup>29</sup>
- Marie Louise [Magdeleine] Renauld [Renaud]**, wife of J. Bte Robidoux [Jean Baptiste Robidou]; 27 years, 13 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Etienne Meloche, Jacques Bezaire and J. Baptiste Meloche [F. Gatien *ptre*]<sup>30</sup>
- Euphrosine Déjarlais**, daughter of Joseph Déjarlais [Jarlais *dit* St. Amand] and Josephte [Dulignon *dite*] Lamirande; two years and about nine months, 14 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Etienne Guiguerre, *bedeau*, and Louis Minville *dit* Deschênes [Marchand *ptre curé*]<sup>31</sup>
- Jacques Langlois**, son of Jean Baptiste Langlois and Charlotte Réaume; six and a half years, 21 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Pierre Cazavan *dit* Ladebauche [Casavant *dit* Ladébauche] and Jean Baptiste Pilet
- Joseph Pouget**, died at Amherstburg, 73 years, 23 August 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Jaques Parent and Antoine Boufard *père Encien [sic] marguillier*
- Joseph Bélanger**, son of Philippe Bélanger and Elisabeth Vallé; about 14 years, died at *la rivierre à la tranche* [Thames River], 14 September 1801, buried 16 September 1801 in cemetery in presence of Benjamin Auger and Ethienne Giguere, *bedeau*
- Cécile Badichon** [Descompte/Descomps *dite* Labadie *dite* Badichon], wife of François Mété; about 24-½ years, 18 September 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Antoine Descompte *dit* Badichon and Louis Goyeau [Goyau/Gouyou]<sup>32</sup>

- Marianne Fournier**, wife of Jean Baptiste Babeu, soldier in the Second Battalion of His Majesty of the Royal Canadian Volunteers; about 32 years, 25 October 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Dominique Goulait [Goulet] and Ethienne Giguerre, *bedeau*<sup>36</sup>
- Alexis Arcouête** [Arcouet], about 58 years, 30 October 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Hyppolite Janis and Joseph Mailloux [F. Gatien *ptre*]<sup>37</sup>
- Jean McGregor**, son of Gregoire McGregor *ecuieur* [squire] and Susanne Robert; nine years and nine months, 29 November 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Jean McGregor, his cousin; Guillaume Hains [Hands]; Alexandre Harron *ecuier* and several other relatives and friends [Marchand *ptre*]
- Thomas Sandascoia**, Huron chief from *la rivierre au Canard* [rivière aux Canards]; about 45 years, 4 December 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Thomas McKie [McKee], *Intendant des Sauvages* [Indian Agent]; Charles Réaume, interpreter; François Perthuys [Perthuis], *chantre*, and many others from his *canton*
- Antoine Moriceau** [Morisseau], about 59 years, 26 December 1801, buried in cemetery in presence of Ethienne Giguerre, *bedeau*, and Laurent Maudet [*sic*]<sup>38</sup>
- Louise Meloche**, wife of Pierre Prudeum [Prudhomme]; 32 years, 13 January 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of J. Baptiste Bygras [Bigras *dit* Fauvel] and Chrisostome Pajot [Marchand *ptre*, F. Gatien *ptre*]<sup>39</sup>
- Jaques Tacheleau**, son of [Joseph Tacheleau (Taschereau)] and Therese Rubau; 32 months and four days, 14 January 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Ethienne Giguerre, *bedeau*, and Crisisthème Pajot [Marchand *ptre*]<sup>40</sup>
- François Meloche**, about 36 years, 10 February 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of François Mété and Pierre Réaume *dit* Thémus
- Monique Lauson**, daughter of François Lauson and Josephte Roy; 9 [*sic*] days, 19 February 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Chrysostome Pajot and Etienne Giguerre<sup>41</sup> [F. Gatien *ptre*]
- Child of Thomas **Digé** [Diguier] *dit* Courtois and Marie Julie Réaume; *ondoyé à la maison*, 28 March 1802, and died shortly after birth; 29 March 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Etienne Giguerre, *bedeau*, and Christostôme Pajot<sup>42</sup>
- Thérèse Leduc**, wife of Paul Poissant *dit* Lasaline [LaSaline]; 33 years, 9 April 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of François Pratte [Duprat], Dominique and François Gaudet [Godet/Godé], and Louis Goyeau [Goyau/Gouyou] [Marchand *ptre*]<sup>43</sup>
- Son of Louis **Robidou** and the deceased Marie Louise Renauld; [no age given, just the word ans (years)], 4 April [May] 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Dominique [Gaudet/Godet/Godé *dit*] Marentet[te] and Chrisosthème Pajot [F. Gatien *ptre*]<sup>44</sup>

- Sara**, *négresse*, slave of Henry Bertelette [Berthelet *dit* Savoyard], *négociant* [merchant] in this parish; about 60 years, 5 May 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Henry Bertelette, her master, and François Perthuys, *chantré* [Marchand *ptre*]
- Geneviève Amable Fauvelle dite Bigras** [Bigras *dite* Fauvel], wife of Paul Campeau, from *la rivierre aux raisin* diocese of Baltimore; died in the *bourg* of Amhurst [Amherstburg] in this parish, about 72 years, 15 May 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of François Berard [*sic*], her son-in-law, and Ethienne Buissonnet [Étienne Bissonnet]<sup>45</sup>
- Jean Baptiste Meloche**, son of Antoine Meloche and [RéGINE] Angélique [Guillet *dite*] Tourangeau; 36 days, 23 May 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Ethienne Giguere, *bedeau*, and Joseph Mallioux<sup>46</sup>
- Antoine Boufard**, son of Antoine Boufard and Marie Louise [Pelletier *dite*] Antailla; one day, 6 June 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of his parents, Etienne Giguere and Antoine Pajot [F. Gatién *ptre*]
- Son of Antoine **Boufard** and Marie Louise Antailla; *ondoyé à la maison* and died 5 June 1802, a few hours old, 6 June 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Étienne Giguere and Antoine Pajot<sup>47</sup>
- Joseph Borell** [Borrel], *négociant*, 64 years, 12 June 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Jaques Parent, Alexis Maisonville, *écuier*, Claude Thomas Réaume, and François Pratte [Marchand *ptre*]<sup>48</sup>
- Jacques** [Joseph written in margin] **Boulet** [Boulay], 78 years, 4 July 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Étienne Giguère and Chrisostome Pajot [F. Gatién *ptre*]<sup>49</sup>
- Jaques Langlois**, son of Nicolas Langlois and Magdeleine Pilet; about 25 years, 29 July 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Pierre Réaume, *marguillier en charge*, his cousin, and Ethienne Giguere, *bedeau* [Marchand *ptre*]
- Michel Chardonnet**, 81 years, 13 August 1802, buried in cemetery in presence of Julien Parent and Louis Normandin<sup>50</sup>

- Magdeleine St. Etienne** [Guignard *dite* St. Étienne], wife of Pierre Meloche; 68 years, 20 April 1805, buried in cemetery in presence of J. Bte. Gignac, Antoine Boufard  *fils*, and several others, including her children [Marchand *ptre*]
- Therèse Meloche**, widow of [François] Janis; about 74 years, 2 July 1805, buried in cemetery in presence of Jean Baptiste Ouellette *père*, Thomas Pajot, a large number of relatives, and many other parishioners<sup>89</sup>
