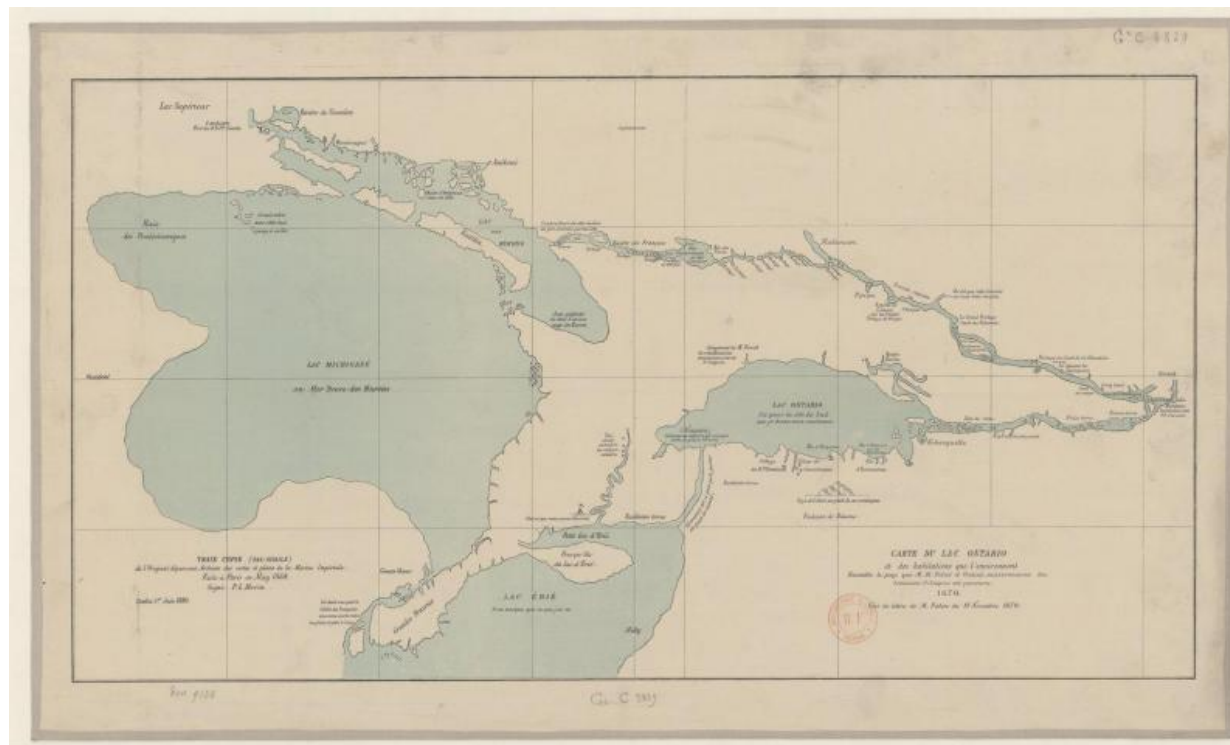


René Bréhant de Galinée

René Bréhant de Galinée and François Dollier de Casson travelled through Lakes Ontario, Erie, the Detroit River, and Lake Huron to Michilimackinac in 1669. They learned about the route to Michilimackinac through Lakes Ontario, Erie, and Huron from Adrien Jolliet who had ransomed an Iroquois prisoner at Michilimackinac.
