

Confirmations at Kebec 8 April 1670

Transcriber's notes: These confirmations are found on FHL film #1311432, item #14 and also on the indicated PRDH Online certificates. The names are transcribed as found on the film and have not been standardized, as they are on PRDH Online. Names followed by an asterisk [*] are not shown in the *Dictionnaire Jetté [DJ]* as having been confirmed. [Note from Suzanne Sommerville - Jetté may have omitted recording some confirmations because he used these references, sometimes, to establish the first presence of an individual in New France. If a person was documented before the confirmation took place, he used the earlier date.] A double asterisk [**] indicates the name could not be found in *DJ*. Family names in parentheses are as shown in *DJ*. Transcriber's comments are in brackets. References are cited at the end of the lists.

francois Poet, ** from Rouen

Jean vincent, * from *Angoulesme* [Arrived 30 June 1665, soldier in the Company of Monteil in the Regiment of Poitou; killed by the Iroquois 21 September 1687, buried Bellevue (*DJ*, 1129)].

Paul quartier, * from Poitiers (Cartier)

Pierre de l'homme, ** bishopric of *Xaintes* [Delhomme on PRDH]

Dominique Roussel, ** bishopric of Montpellier

Philippe Louvigny, ** from Paris [Philippe Louvigny was a witness at three abjurations in Québec: (1) Pierre Glomont, from St-Jean-d'Angély, diocese of Saintes, 22 November 1668; (2) Elie Lhomme, from St-Jean-d'Angély, diocese of Saintes, 22 November 1668; and (3) Timothée Jousseau, from Marenes, diocese of la Rochelle, 25 June 1669 (PRDH #404014, #404015, #404019).] [Abjurations: rejections of a non-Catholic faith in order to become Catholics]

Gabriel d'auray, * from *Angoulesme* (Doré)

Michel Maillau, from *Xaintes* (Mailloux)

Claude Larche, ** from Paris [Claude Larche Champagne, from Paris, was buried 20 July 1670 in Québec (PRDH #102300); Claude Larcher received the *scapulaire* of Mont-Carmel in Québec, 30 August 1665 (Langlois, 381).] [*Scapulaire du Mont-Carmel*]:

Andre Migné, * from la Rochelle (Mignier *dit* Lagacé) [Arrived 30 June 1665 as a soldier in the Company of Berthier in the Allier Regiment (*DJ*, 812).]

Mathurine Renaut, from la Rochelle (Renaut) [Married Jean Sabourin about 1666 in La Rochelle (*DJ*, 1027).] [PRDH #403740]

francoise la claire, * from *Angoulesme* (Leclerc) [Married Michel Rifault, 27 August 1668 in Québec. After the birth and baptism of their last child, Michel, 24 August 1676, in Québec, there is no further mention of the family in Québec (PRDH #66783, #2517; *DJ*, 985); arrived in 1668; returned to France about 1676 with her husband and four sons: Jean, Louis, Michel and Toussaint (*Navires*).]

Marie Jodeau, * from la Rochelle [Jodeau on PRDH] (Jodon) [Widow of François Pavageault; married André Barbeau *dit* Laforest, 12 August 1669 in Québec (*DJ*, 45). Probably arrived at the end of June 1669, at Québec, on board *le Pot de Beurre* (*Navires*).]

Thomas Cavé, ** from Rouen

Louys Sabottier, ** from la Rochelle

Jacques d'airé, ** from la Rochelle

francois Aymé, ** from *Xaintes* [François Aymé was godfather to François Jahan, son of Jacques Jahan and Marie Ferra, 15 June 1682, at Ste-Famille, Île-d'Orléans, and was a witness at the wedding of Noël Charlan and Marie Turcot, 29 October 1682, at Ste-Famille, Île-d'Orléans (PRDH #31732, #32672).]

francois Crenaille, ** from Targe in Portugal

J. B. gausset, from *Lysieux* [Jean Baptiste on PRDH] (Gosset, *sieur* DuBuisson)

J. B. Gaudon, ** from Paris [Jean Baptiste on PRDH; Jean Baptiste Godon Bellefontaine, born *circa* 1647, from the parish of St-Paul in Paris; buried 10 August 1692 in *Hôtel-Dieu de Québec*. The name of Mongaudon is also attributed to him (PRDH #252042, #66977, #59213, #7009).]

Louys hé, ** from Chartres

Pierre Leaume, ** from *Xaintes*

Pierre Charron, ** from *Xaintes*

Francois Gaignet, ** from la Rochelle

Guillaume Vallade, * from la Rochelle (Valade)

Elie Jean, * from la Rochelle [Jean on PRDH] (Jean *dit* Godin) [Arrived at Québec at the end of June 1669 on *le Pot de Beurre (Navires)*.]

Simeon le Roy, * from Coutance (Roy or Leroy *dit* Ody or Audy)

francoise Anselme, ** from la Rochelle [Possibly Françoise Ancelin, wife of Guillaume Valade, married 10 November 1669 in Québec (*DJ*, 1107).]

Jeanne fauveau, * from la Rochelle [Fauvau on PRDH] (Fauvault) [Married Jacques Provost / Prévost, 25 November 1669 in Québec (*DJ*, 950).]

francois Bourin, ** from *Poictiers*

Louyse Senecal, * from Rouen [Married Pierre Guilbault, 6 October 1667 in Québec (*DJ*, 541).]

Toussaint du Bau, * from Paris (Dubeau)

francoise Larchevesque, * from Rouen (Larchevêque) [Married Jean Dubuc 14 January 1668 in Québec (*DJ*, 372); No doubt arrived 25 September 1667 at Québec on *le Saint-Louis (Navires)*.]

Bertrand Courtois, * from S^t Brieu (Courtois *dit* LeBreton)

Jean Richard, from la Rochelle

Marguerite Navarre, * from la Rochelle [Married Étienne Roy, 3 September 1668 in Québec (*DJ*, 1018); probably arrived at the end of June 1669 on *le Pot de Beurre (Navires)*.]

Marie Magdeleine de S^t Lusson, ** from Rouen

Marie gabriele Minaute, * from la Rochelle (Mineau) [Married Pierre Therrien / Terrien, 17 May 1670, Ste-Famille, Île-d'Orléans (*DJ*, 1072; PRDH #32601, #3159).]

Jean fortier, ** from *Seez*

Mathurin Andre Planseau, ** from *Poictiers*

Pierre Thierry Le Vallon, * from *Canadas* (Delestre *dit* Le Vallon / Du Valon)

J. B. Amiot, * from *Canadas* [Jean Baptiste on PRDH]

Marie Le mirrhe, * from *Canadas* (Lemire)

Agathe Magdelaine fournier, * from *Canadas*

Marie Anne Berry, * from *Canadas* (Anceau *dit* Berry)

Marie Therese Le Vasseur, * from *Canadas*

Marguerite Gloria, * from *Canadas*

Jacquette Magdelaine, ** from *Canadas*

Joseph Juchereau, * from *Canadas*

Marie Catherine Reine, ** from *Canadas*

Marguerite Villeneuve, ** from *Canadas* [Possibly Marguerite Amiot *dite* Villeneuve, daughter of Mathieu Amiot and Marie Miville (*DJ*, 12).]

Catherine de Lauzon, * from *Canadas*

Marie Magdelaine des Moulins, from *Canadas*

Elizabeth d'amours, * from *Canadas* (Damours)

Louys Couillard, * from *Canadas*

J. Baptiste Couillard, * from *Canadas* [Jean Baptiste on PRDH]

Jean Baptiste Prevost, * from *Canadas*
