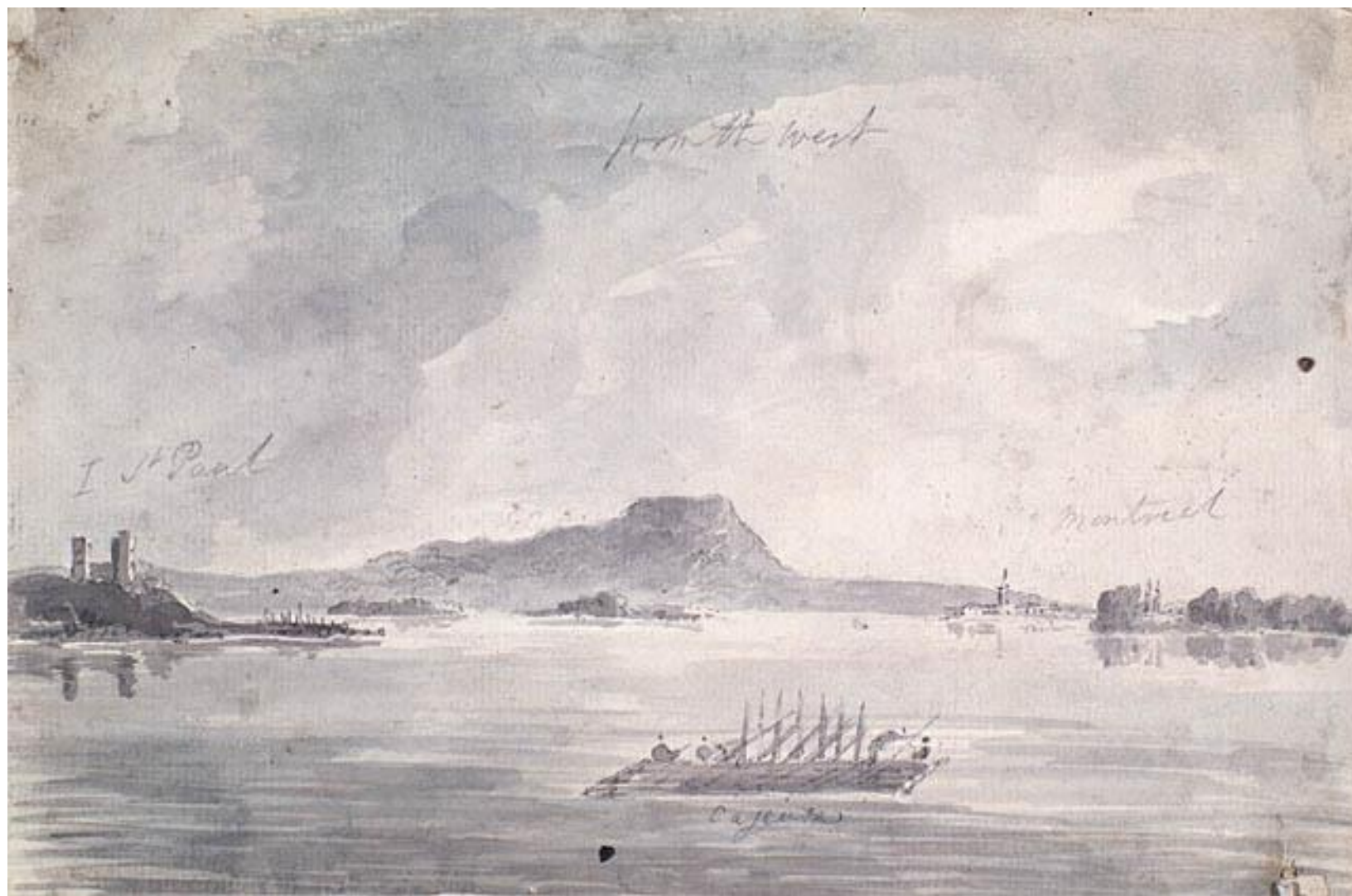

Mrs. Simcoe copied this portrait from a drawing made by Henry Hamilton, governor of Detroit (1775-79) (later governor of Quebec). The drawing is in the collection of the Houghton Library at Harvard. Because Mrs. Simcoe was not familiar with print techniques, she forgot to reverse the order of her plate inscription, although she remembered to reverse each individual letter.
