Pierre St. Onge *dit* Martineau, killed the same day about noon in his field by the *Sauteurs* [Chippewas], about 60 years, 31 August 1747. Père Bonnaventure was “persuaded” that St. Onge was religious so he did accord him a religious burial in the cemetery.
