

People Buried from Ste. Anne de Detroit (1787-1793): Part V¹

[Note: The following names in bold indicate that recorded proof was found that the individual was at Détroit by 1710, the founding period of the colony. Names in brackets at the end of some entries name the presiding priest and will also serve to show how long that priest was at Détroit. Names are as written in the original parish register. Additional material, in brackets, are the transcriber's comments. The dates given are burial dates. In several of the following records, the information recorded by the presiding priest is incorrect. For several of these entries, I have noted corrections and additional information in a footnote. In some cases, there are also discrepancies with the entries in Denissen for specific families. Some of those discrepancies are mentioned.]

Marie Louise Robert, four months, 25 July 1787, buried in cemetery
Pierre [Bienvenu *dit*] Delisle, one month, 28 July 1787, buried in cemetery
Gabriel, *panis* belonging to Céré; baptized in Monforton's house; about eight years, 31 July 1787, buried in cemetery
Antoine Debutte St. Martin [Beaudry], merchant in this city; son of Jacque S^t Martin and Marie Anne Navar; 24 years, 2 August 1787, buried in the *allée du milieu de l'église*
Chatarine, *panisse* of Pelletier, about 60 years, 3 August 1787, buried in cemetery
Marie Rose, one month, 8 August 1787, buried in cemetery
Jean Baptiste Saintonge, came to *ces pays* this year from the parish of Saint Martin, Government of Montreal, about 23 years, 31 August 1787, buried in cemetery
François Reaume, four years, 6 September 1787, buried in cemetery
Charlotte, *panis*, one month, 13 September 1787, buried in cemetery

² Married Marie Louise Courtois, daughter of Thomas Courtois and Josèphe Savard [PRDH #19175], 27 July 1761, at Ste. Anne de Detroit. Jean Baptiste Dubergé said he was from the parish of St-Georges in the city of Vivonne, Vienne, (Poitou), France [Sharon A. Kelley, ed., *Marriage Records Ste. Anne Church Detroit 1701 – 1850* (Detroit: The Detroit Society for Genealogical Research, Inc., 2001), 15]. Jean Baptiste Dubergé and Marie Louise Courtois were the parents of ten children, four of whom survived to adulthood [Rev. Christian Denissen, *Genealogy of the French Families of the Detroit River Region 1701-1936*. rev. ed. (Detroit: Detroit Society for Genealogical Research, 1987), I: 414-415]. Their son Jean Baptiste married twice: (1) Geneviève Langlois, 8 January 1793, at Québec; (2) Mary Plumly, 27 May 1812, Hôpital Général de Québec. Jean Baptiste Dubergé, *fils*, who became a surveyor in Québec, left many descendants. ³ Joseph Trudel, daughter of François Trudel and Joseph Fovel, was baptized, 6 July 1783, at Ste. Anne de Detroit. Joseph Trudel died 29 May 1787 and was buried the next day in the cemetery of Ste. Anne de Detroit, aged about four years. Marie Trudel, same parents, was born 9 December 1785 and baptized the next day at Ste. Anne de Detroit [image 53 of 625]. Her birth and baptism are not in Denissen, II, 1208. It is Marie who married (1) Henri Larose, 13 February 1804, and (2) Jacques Rocheleau *dit* Desplat, 1 February 1813 [Kelley, ed., 55, 77]. Marie Trudelle, aged about 29 years, was buried, 9 December 1813, in the cemetery of Ste. Anne de Detroit [Ste. Anne Autres Registres, 1801-1842, image 40 of 94].

⁴ Possibly Étienne Pascal Brière, son of Charles Brière and Marie Anne Pleau *dite* Lafleur, born and baptized, 13 April 1721, at Cap-Santé [PRDH #8861].

⁵ Pierre Laurent [Cosme *dit*] St. Cosme, son of Pierre St. Cosme and Marie Elisabeth Faille Lafayette, married Catherine Laudeman [Lotman] Barrois, daughter of François Laudeman Barrois and Marie Anne Sauvage, 25 January 1747, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [PRDH #35409]. His father, **Pierre Cosme/Côme dit Lajeunesse** had been at Détroit, 22 March 1709, when he purchased a house from **Jean Ferland dit Deloriers**, on *rue* St. Joachim, in a contract by **Étienne Veron, sieur de Grandmesnil**.

⁶ Louis Maison, son of Louis Maison and Catherine Patenotre, was born 11 September 1787, baptized the 15th at Ste. Anne de Detroit; died 20 September 1787, buried the 21st at Ste. Anne de Detroit. His birth and burial are not in Denissen, II, 849, under the family name of Moison / Maison. The original name for this family was Armand dit la Maison de Bois. The father, Louis, was actually Louis Armand, son of Jacques Armand and Anne Bernier. See PRDH #16403, #1769, #161219.

⁷ Antoine Catin Labadie married Marie Anne Martin, 21 November 1768, at Montréal. No parents were listed for him. Antoine was said to be 25 years old and native to Détroit. His brother, Jean Baptiste Labadie, was a witness [PRDH #213136]. When Antoine *Catain* was buried from Ste. Anne de Detroit, 25 December 1787, he was said to be 49 years old [image 89 of 625]. Thus, Antoine Catin Labadie was born between 1738 and 1743, in an unknown location, and of unknown parents. [This does not agree with the family of Achin *dit* Catin found in Denissen, I, 230.]

⁸ Charles Vesina, son of Louis Vesina and Marie Josephe Algrain, was baptized, 29 July 1778, at Québec [PRDH #623144].

⁹ Augustin Lafoy, son of Antoine Lafoy and Marie Elisabeth Morand, married Elisabeth St. Cosme, daughter of Pierre Laurent St. Cosme and Catherine Barrois, 28 November 1763, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [PRDH #95095].

¹⁰ Possibly Louis Pierre Ratel, son of Pierre Ratel and Marie Françoise Bousquet. Louis Pierre married twice: (1) Marie Josèphe Larivière Letarte, 5 July 1762, at Montréal; (2) Marie Théotiste Poliquin, 21 January 1771, at Repentigny. Marie Poliquin remarried 7 September 1790 at L'Assomption to Jean Baptiste Venne [PRDH #74326, #47217, #39461, #17036].

¹¹ Théotiste [Cosme] Saint Cosme, daughter of Pierre Come [see footnote #4] and Catherine Lotman Barrois, married Philippe Dejean, 25 November 1776, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Kelley, ed., 27]. Philippe Dejean was not listed as one of the witnesses to her funeral nor did he sign as a witness. The fate of Philippe Dejean is unknown.

¹² Possibly son of Pierre Morin and Marie Josephe Chauvin, born, 6 January 1773, at Boucherville [PRDH #39892].

¹³ Josèphe Bellanger married Jean Henri Frederic, 4 May 1779, at Québec. They were the parents of four known children, all of whom died between 1780 - 1786 [PRDH #212640, #55404].

¹⁴ Charles François Girardin, widower of Marie Louise Lecerf, married Marie Louise Leclair [Leclerc], widow of [Joseph] Caron, 24 September 1785, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Kelley, ed., 33]. Her sister, also named Marie Louise, married Louis Dumouchel, 12 January 1739, at Montreal [PRDH #12436, #87067]. The sisters were the daughters of Sauveur Germain Leclerc and Marie Geneviève Hervieux [PRDH #12436].

¹⁵ Charles Madox, son of Daniel Joseph Madox and Marie Anne Laselle, married Marie Charlotte Loiselle, 10 April 1758, at Pointe-aux-Trembles. Their only surviving child, Marie Charlotte Madox, married Daniel Goisneau, 6 October 1788, at Montréal. Charles Madox did not appear to be present since he did not sign. However, Philippe

¹⁶ It is possible that Pierre Dugué was the father of a child, also called Pierre Dugué. Pierre Dugué, about 14 years, the son of the deceased Pierre Dugué and a *sauvagesse*, was baptized, 5 July 1790, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Denissen, I, 432].

¹⁷ Jean Baptiste *Boujon* [Bousom dit Gascon] from the *bourg d'Amon*, parish of Saint Pierre [Amou, Landes, France,] married Isabelle Drouillard, 22 January 1777, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Kelley, ed., 27]. The marriage act is difficult to decipher, but his mother's name was Laurence d'*Arouteche*. He appears to have had a sister, Marie Louise [daughter of Jean Bousom and Laurence *Larrouset*] who married at Amou, 30 May 1789, to Jean Moulia [acte #300620017560810231, at www.genealogie.com (a subscription site)].

¹⁸ Agathe, daughter of Pierre Robert and Agathe Casse dite St. Aubin, was born and baptized, 3 August 1788, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [image 102 of 625]. She is not in Denissen, II, 1079.

¹⁹ **Marie Anne Casse dite St-Aubin**, daughter of **Jean Casse** and **Louise Gauthier**, was born, 5 October 1710, at Detroit. She married Charles Chauvin, 27 October 1726, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Kelley, ed., 2].

²⁰ Joseph Bourdeau married Louise Clermont, 14 April 1760, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Kelley, ed., 14].

²¹ Possibly Madeleine Pruneau, wife of Jean Baptiste Casse dit St. Aubin and Vital Caron. Marie Hélène dite Madeleine Pruneau, daughter of Jean Pruneau and Suzanne Émond, was born on the 20th and baptized, 22 June 1708, at Montmagny [René Jetté, *Dictionnaire généalogique des familles du Québec des origines à 1730* (Les Presses de l'Université de Montréal: Montréal), 952]. Madeleine married (1) Jean Baptiste [Casse dit] St. Aubin, 31 July 1731, at Ste. Anne de Detroit; (2) Vital Caron, 20 July 1735, at Ste. Anne de Detroit [Kelley, ed., 3, 4].

²² Son of **Jean Louis Campeau** and **Marie Louise Robert**; baptized, 30 March 1735, at Détroit; married Catherine Ménard, 17 August 1761, at Montréal [PRDH #161894].

²³ Jean Brillant / Brian dit Beaulieu, a soldier, son of Jean Brillant and Jeanne Vigno/Vigne from the parish of La Toussaint, Rennes, France, married Françoise Itagisse, 10 July 1752, at Michilimakinac, with the permission of his captain [Marthe Faribault-Beauregard, *La population des forts français d'Amérique (XVIIIe siècle)* (Éditions Bergeron: Montréal, 1982), I, 122].

²⁴ Probably a son of Jacques Cardinal and Jeanne Duguay. Evidently there is some confusion involving two of their sons: (1) Joseph was born and baptized, 16 October 1720, at Montréal. This appears to be his burial record. There are a number of records for Joseph Cardinal, son of Jacques Cardinal and Jeanne Duguay, at Ste. Anne de Detroit. There is no indication that Joseph Cardinal ever married. (2) Nicolas Joseph was born 24th, baptized 25 August 1723, at Montréal. According to PRDH, Nicolas Joseph married, 1 January 1761, at Fort Vincennes to Marie Josephe Girard, daughter of Jean Baptiste Girard and Marie Josephe Raymond. PRDH indicates it is Nicolas Joseph who was buried at Detroit in June 1789 [PRDH #11896]. However, Nicolas Joseph was always known as Nicolas in the records at Vincennes [Marthe Faribault-Beauregard, II, 20, 34, 35]. Nicolas Cardinal died 24 August 1789 at Vincennes and is buried in the cemetery of the Cathedral there. See <http://graves.inssar.org/C/cardnich.html> for a picture of his cemetery marker.

²⁵ Marie Charles Vermette, daughter of Joseph Vermette and Marie Rose [Josette] Campau, was born and baptized, 1 July 1789, at Assumption, Sandwich. She was not buried there the next day as indicated in Denissen, II, 1235. See www.ancestry.ca, Drouin Collection, Assumption, Sandwich, 1781-1808, image 79 of 323.

²⁶ Possibly Joseph Lemire *dit* Marsolet, son of Joseph Lemire *dit* Marsolet and Marie Madeleine Gaudry, born about 1730 in an unknown location in present-day Québec. There is no death date for him on PRDH, although it is indicated that his second wife, Marie Claire Ritchot, was buried, 31 December 1804, at St-Roch-l'Achigan. When his son, Louis Antoine, was married on 22 February 1791, at St-Roch-l'Achigan, to Marie Hippolyte Juneau, Joseph Lemire was said to be deceased.

²⁷ Angélique Morand married (1) Joseph Pascal Viger, 25 October 1768, at Varennes [PRDH #333399]; (2) Joseph Cabassier, 15 January 1781, Detroit [Denissen, I, 189].

²⁸ Possibly Pierre Morin, baptized, 3 July 1727, at Longueuil, son of Pierre Morin and Marie Josephe Daunais, and husband of Marie Josephe Chauvin [PRDH #39892, #164475]. Also, possibly the father of Joseph Morin, buried, 1 September 1788, at Detroit.
